

GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition

- Finally, there will be a 1 hour 30 minute written examination paper to be taken at any one of the eight Tutors & Exams [centres](#) located in the UK

The programme will consist of 30, 1½ hour virtual sessions, this will be theory and practical and 4 practical face-to-face sessions to be hosted at 1 Weeford Park Cottages, London Road, Sutton Coldfield, B75 5ST.

The fee for the course, covering tutorials and practical sessions, is £500 (without booking fees) and will be charged to you directly by Worship Worth Experiences.
