Meeting the applicable entry deadline is essential.

Tutors & Exams deadlines may be earlier than the final deadlines published by an awarding organisation. This gives us sufficient time to check candidate information, review supporting evidence, resolve queries, process payment and submit complete and accurate entries before the awarding organisation's closing date. To qualify for the standard entry fee, a complete booking – including all required information, supporting evidence and payment – must be received by the applicable standard entry deadline.

Applications must be complete—including all required information, supporting evidence and payment—by the closing date.

Entries for these qualifications will not be accepted after 14 March 2027. Candidates are strongly encouraged to apply early because additional information, an approved tutor or provider, speaking assessments, coursework or practical arrangements may be required.

ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS

SUPPORTING A CANDIDATE'S NORMAL WAY OF WORKING

Access Arrangements support candidates who have a disability, learning difficulty, medical condition or other need that affects how they access an examination. They are intended to remove an unnecessary disadvantage without changing what is being assessed or giving the candidate an unfair advantage.

Where required by the applicable regulations, the requested arrangement must reflect the candidate's normal way of working. This means the support the candidate ordinarily and routinely uses while learning, working or completing assessments—not support introduced only for the examination. For example, if a candidate requests the use of a word processor, extra time, supervised rest breaks, a reader or a scribe, the evidence may need to show that this type of support is normally used and is appropriate to the candidate's needs.

Evidence of a diagnosis or medical condition may not, by itself, establish the candidate's normal way of working. Supporting information may also be required from a school, college, tutor, workplace, medical professional or another suitable person who understands how the candidate normally works. Private candidates who do not attend a school or college should contact the Access Arrangements Team as early as possible. The team will explain what evidence may be accepted to demonstrate the candidate's needs and normal way of working.

Every request is considered individually. The arrangement available will depend on the candidate's needs, the evidence provided, their normal way of working, the applicable regulations and what can reasonably be delivered at the chosen centre.

Candidates who may require Access Arrangements should contact the Tutors & Exams Access Arrangements Team well before the relevant evidence submission deadline. The dates below are deadlines for receiving all required evidence. They are not deadlines for making an initial enquiry or starting the process.

Submitting an enquiry or initial form without the required evidence does not meet the evidence submission deadline.

MOCK EXAMINATIONS

Preparing for an examination can feel daunting. A mock examination allows candidates to experience realistic examination conditions in a safe and controlled environment before sitting their formal assessments.

Mock examinations can help candidates:

- Become familiar with examination procedures and expected conduct.
- Understand the format and structure of an examination paper.
- Practise completing papers within the permitted time.
- Develop examination technique and time-management skills.
- Identify subjects or topics that may require further preparation.
- Build confidence by experiencing realistic examination conditions.

For candidates who experience examination-related anxiety, becoming familiar with the environment and procedures may help reduce uncertainty and provide a greater sense of preparedness. A mock examination cannot guarantee a particular result or future examination performance, but it can provide a valuable opportunity to practise and identify areas for improvement.

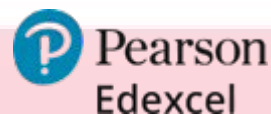
